

A New Passage to India**WISE – Working Internships in Science and Engineering
for Indian Bachelor Students****Announcement 2009/2010****Objectives**

2-3 months internship at institutions of higher education and research institutes in Germany with German doctoral students, scientists or professors on research projects.

Target Group

- Undergraduate students from selected Indian Universities (see list attached)
- Graduate students who are registered for a Postgraduate course at selected Indian Universities (see list attached) and who have completed “WISE” internship during their undergraduate studies (reapplication)

Duration

Duration of 2 up to 3 months, but not exceeding 90 days

**Scholarship
Value**

- A monthly stipend of Euro 650 * to cover living expenses
- A lump sum towards travel Euro 525
- Compulsory health insurance covered by DAAD

*The monthly instalment will be calculated on a daily basis

**Requirements
and Conditions**

- Full time Indian undergraduate students in their 5th, 6th and 7th Semester registered at one of the selected Indian Universities (see list attached)
- **For reapplication only:** Full time Indian graduate students in their 1st and 2nd semester registered at one of the selected Indian Universities (see list attached)
- Above average marks: Aggregate marks of 75 % and above or CGPA 3.5/ 4 or 7.5/ 10 of completed semesters at the time of application
- Detailed motivation letter
- Acceptance cum invitation letter from a German Professor for the internship. Only one invitation letter will be accepted.
- German language skills are not mandatory

Application Documents

To be arranged in the order mentioned below:

- **3** print-outs of the DAAD online application form submitted online with a passport-size photograph attached to each form. Please ensure that you have duly signed all the forms before sending them to us**
- **3** typed copies of full curriculum-vitae (bio-data)
- **3** copies of letter of motivation from the student
- **3** copies of "Certificate of enrolment" (see attached ZAV form) needs to be filled by the student and attested by his parent University
- **3** copies of the invitation letter from German host signed by the Head of the respective department including a summary of the research project in which the candidate will be placed. The summary can be mentioned in the invitation letter or in the form "Offer by German Host"
- **3** copies of the form "Offer by German Host" to be filled and signed by the German Professor. The name and address of the person supervising the intern should be clearly mentioned in the form
- **1** reference from senior academic mentor from the applicant's field of study on the proforma available on our website. The referee's title and academic status should be **clearly** indicated in this (with official rubber-stamp). This should be **CONFIDENTIAL** (in sealed envelopes) and should be recent-dated
- **3** copies of all chronologically arranged university/ college certificates and mark-sheets (all copies must be attested; attested English translation, if the originals are in Hindi; Attestation can be done by a gazetted Government officer. Photocopies must be attested!

**The internship dates filled by the student on the first page of the application form will be considered final. No further requests for change in dates will be entertained

Application Procedure

The application submission process is online. The link is available on the DAAD New Delhi website.

The **deadline** for submission of applications is 30th of November 2009.

Important:

- DAAD will not consider incomplete applications.
- Only the best of the candidates will be selected.

Information****Kindly Note:**

- Please use **A4** size paper only and **DO NOT staple** the documents
- The first and last name filled in the application form should be **identical** to the name in the Passport
- Candidate must be a resident of India and an Indian national
- Private companies can not be considered under this programme as a German host
- The internship period should always commence at the beginning of a month and preferably end at the end of a month since rental agreements can only be arranged for full months
